Job Summary:

This position is responsible for skilled, licensed work in the operation and maintenance of equipment in water treatment plant. Incumbents in this classification are fully qualified plant operators responsible for the efficient operation of water treatment equipment on an assigned shift, which includes night shifts and holiday hours.
